Soap Making

(Vegan bar soap & laundry detergent)

My interest in soap making began 14 years ago when I began worrying about the chemicals in our bath soap, laundry detergent, and body lotion. I started my new hobby using a few molds from a local store, and then added to the collection as my friends shared their silicone baking molds with me, which by the way, works perfectly with my soap recipe. My dear friend, Teresa Kellams introduced me to the art of soap making and I continue to honor her as I create soap and share the technique with others through classes.

CLASS INFORMATION

We will be discussing and making a gentle laundry soap that can make gallons for a few cents per wash. At the end of the class, you'll take home a sample of the laundry soap (2 cups) and the recipe.

Also, in this class we'll be making a vegan soap using ingredients that are in your local grocery store. You will also get a recipe for making vegan bar soap and take home 4 bars of your own hand-crafted soap 1 week after the class which is the time necessary to allow for hardening.
